Rules for the 2009 Contest

Students in Grades 3-8 are eligible to enter the poster contest.

The Purpose of the Contest is to promote the role and importance of agriculture in our communities today.

All entries should be in the form of Posters. The **Posters must not exceed a size of 11 x 14 inches** and should be done in markers, pencil, or crayon. Contrasting and bright colors are suggested.

Entries must be complete – containing the name of entrant, age, grade level, name of school, names of parents or guardian and their mailing address, complete with ZIP Code and telephone number, and the full name of the teacher or home room teacher. This information should be written on the back or affix the entry to the back. Entry Forms can be found at [www.agricenter.org](http://www.agricenter.org). There is no limit to the number of posters per school.

**Prizes** will be **\$100** for first-place winners, **\$50** for second-place winner, **\$25** for third-place winner, and **\$50** to teachers of first-place winners. The decision of the judges will be final. **WINNING ENTRIES WILL BE FRAMED AND PLACED ON PERMANENT DISPLAY IN AGRICENTER INTERNATIONAL FOR AT LEAST ONE YEAR.**
